Clients by age group

- In the London ER, the largest group of OEAS clients were between 25 and 44 years-old, 44% respectively. A higher proportion of OEAS clients with ages between 15 and 24 years-old were in the London ER than in Western Region or Ontario. The OEAS clients' base in London ER was younger than in Western Region or Ontario.

OEAS clients by age group - London ER, 2016/2017

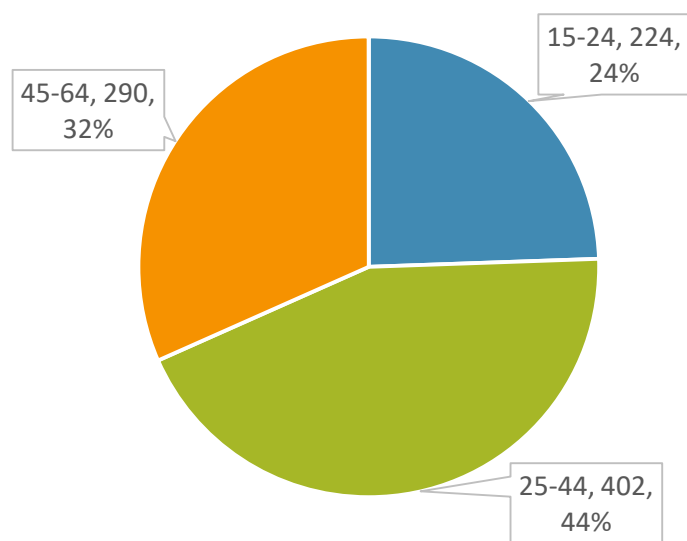

OEAS clients by age group - London ER, 2016/2017

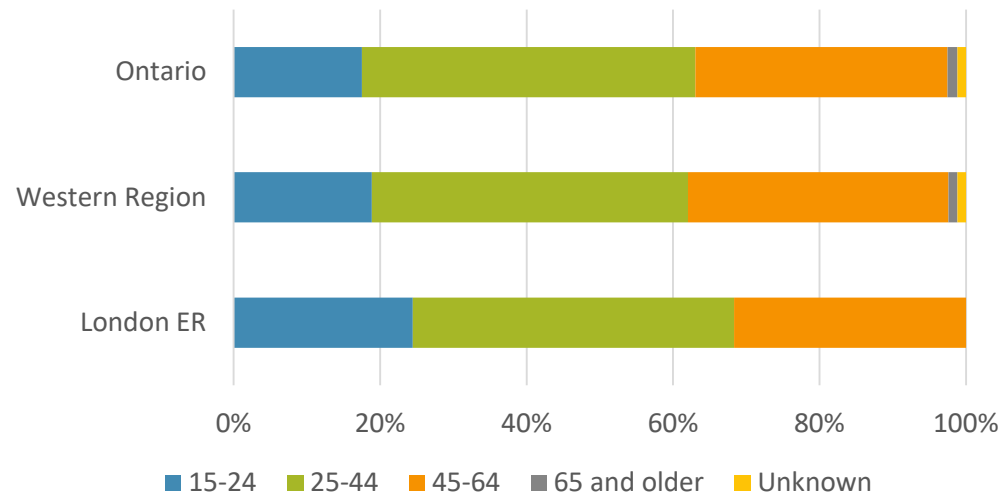

Clients by gender

- The OEAS clients are fairly equal distributed by gender. An slightly higher proportion of males than females.

2016/2017

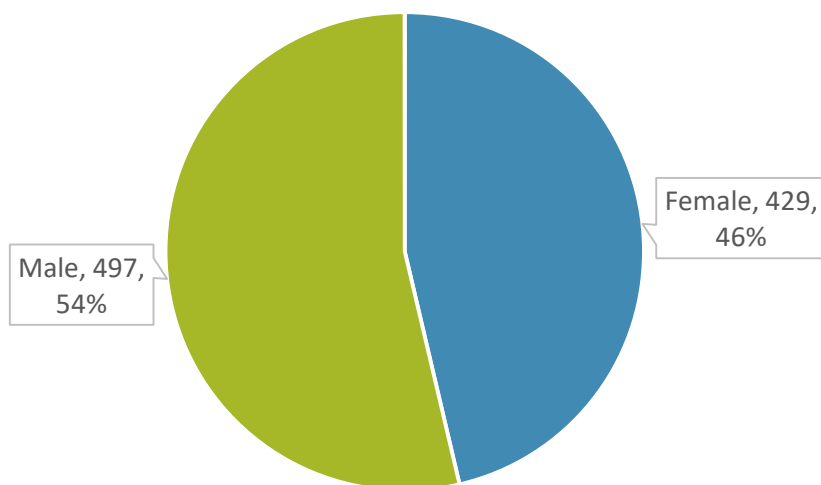

OEAS clients by gender - 2016/2017

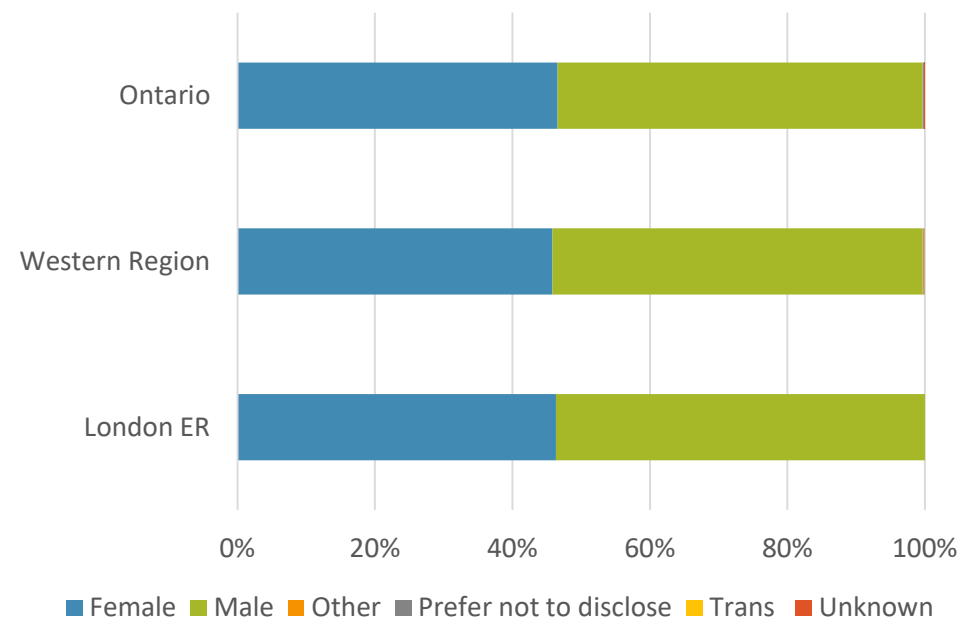

Clients by the highest level of education at intake

- In London ER, the OEAS clients were more likely to have “completed the Secondary” school or to have “less than Grade 12” education at intake, 37% and 24% respectively. Relative to the OEAS clients in Western Region or Ontario, the OEAS clients in London ER were more likely to have “completed the Secondary” school or to have “less than Grade 12” level of education at intake.

OEAS clients by highest level of education at intake - London ER, 2016/2017

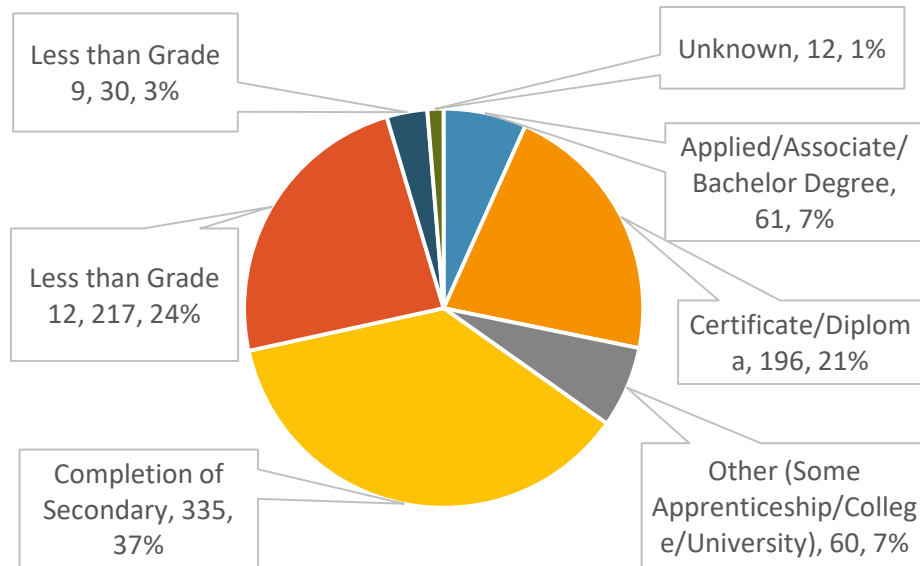

OEAS clients by highest level of education at intake - 2016/2017

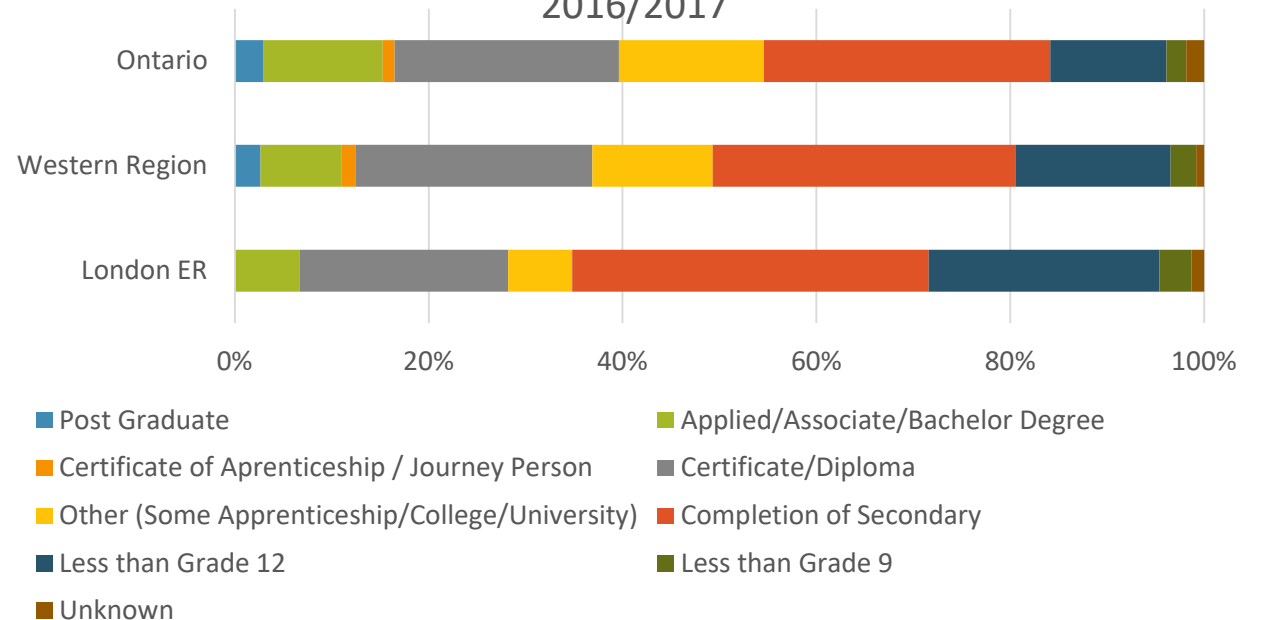

Clients by the designated groups

- In the London ER, most of the OEAS clients were “persons with Disability.” Relative to the clients of the same program in Western Region or Ontario, in London ER the OEAS clients were more likely to be “persons with Disability.”

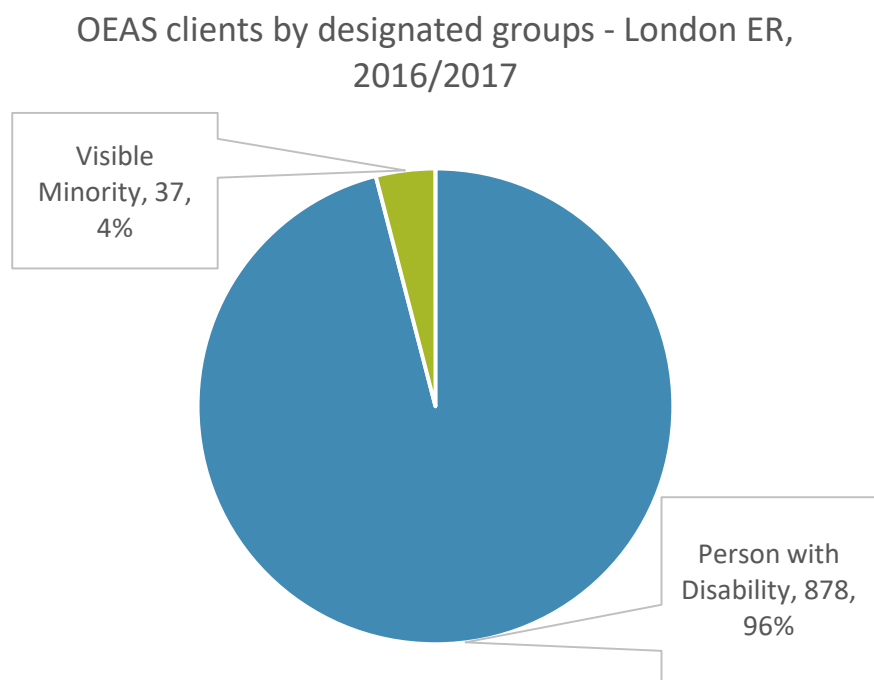

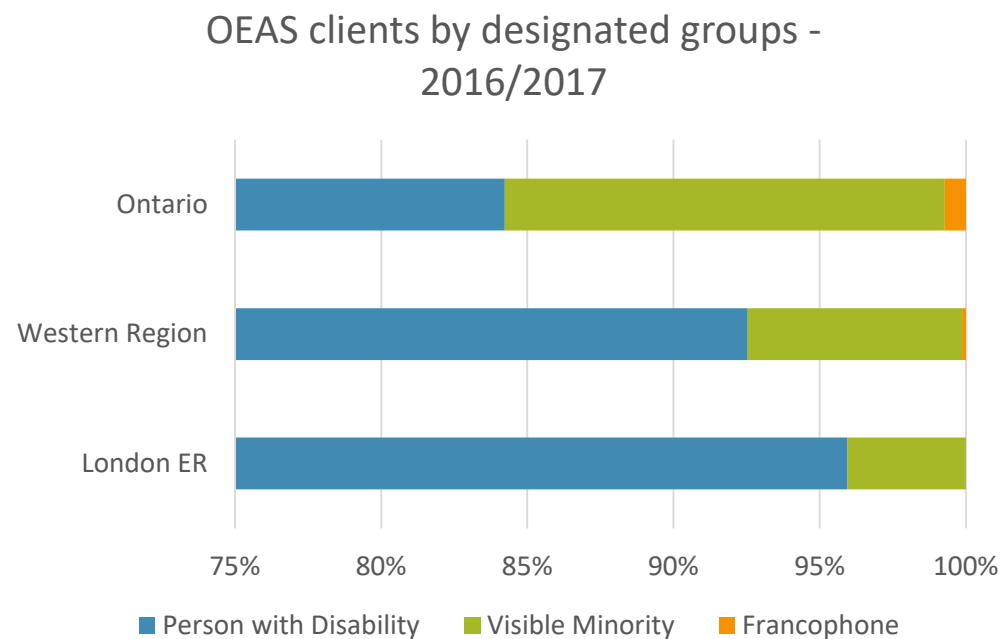

Clients by designated groups

- Almost all the OEAS clients in London ER were associated with a designated group.

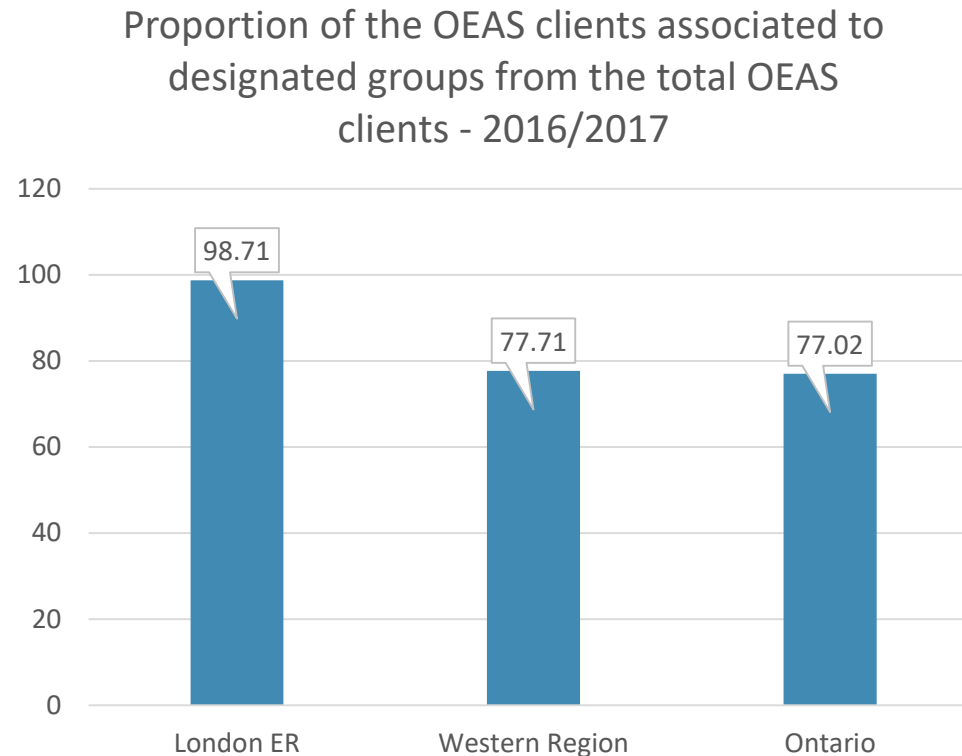

Clients by source of income

- The largest segments of OEAS clients in London ER were living on “Ontario Disability Support Program” and “Ontario Works,” 34% and 26% respectively. A smaller proportion of OEAS program in London ER were reporting as having “no source of income.” Relative to OEAS clients in Western Region or Ontario. The clients of the same program in London ER were more likely to be on the “Ontario Disability Support Program.”

OEAS clients by income source - London ER, 2016/2017

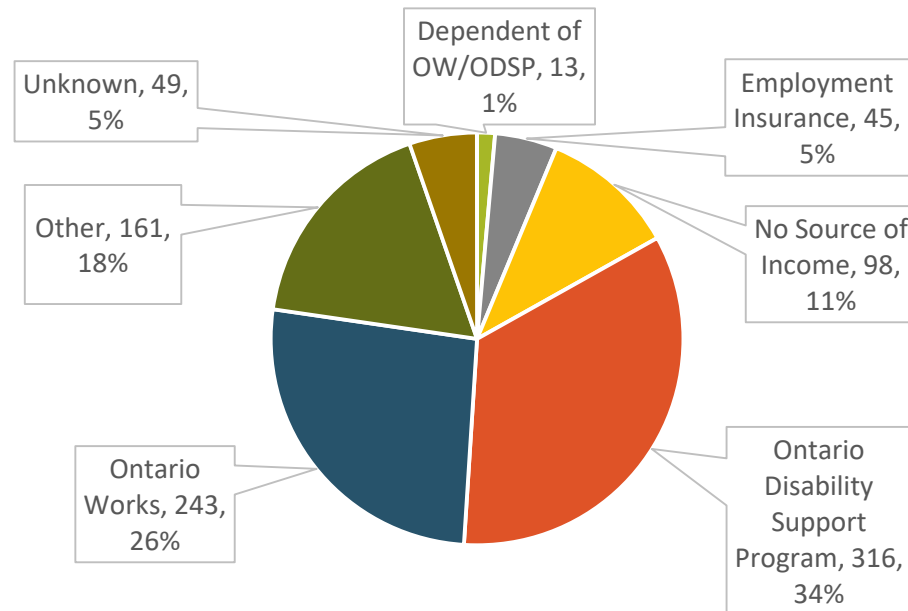

OEAS clients by income source - 2016/2017

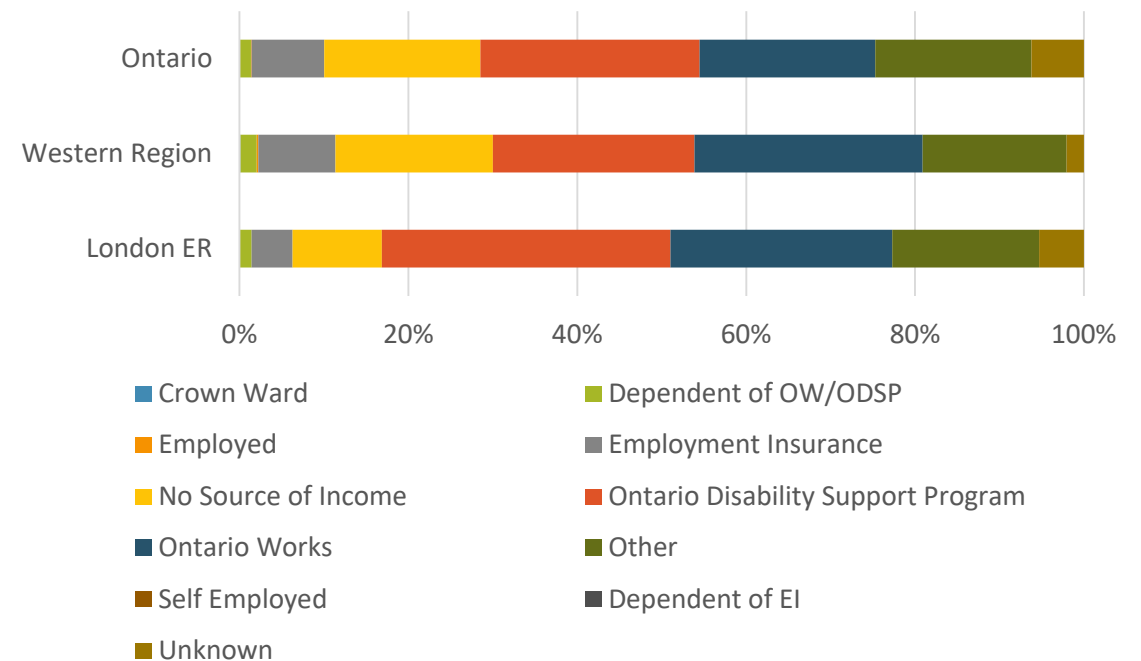
